INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOMEOWNERS/RETAILERS/RECYCLERS

1. Fill out everything in this Certificate of Destruction, including all signatures and required attachments. We do not accept incomplete forms.
2. Completely clean out the old wood-burning device (including fire brick and ash) and remove the door before turning it in for destruction. If this is not done, the recycler will not sign the Certificate. Certificates that are not signed by the recycler are invalid.
3. Attach photos to this Certificate of (1) the old existing installed device, (2) the old device rendered inoperable and (3) the new device installed operational, along with the sales receipt for the new device. If photo(s) and sales receipt are not attached, this Certificate is invalid.
4. Deliver the old wood-burning device to a recycling facility (deadlines provided in "CERTIFICATION" section at bottom of page).
